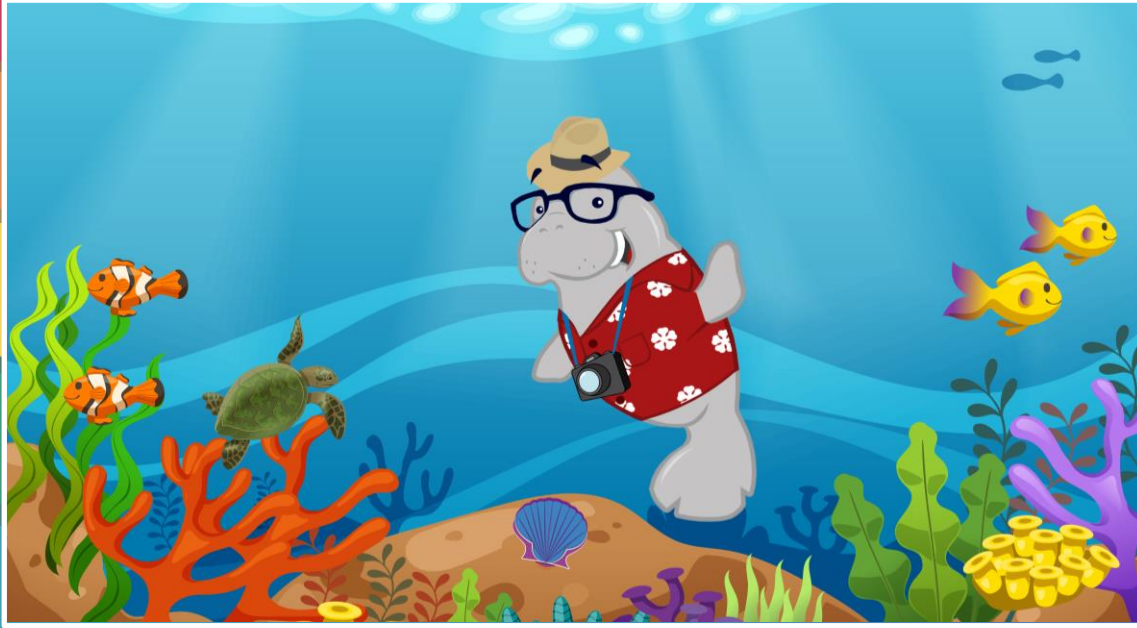

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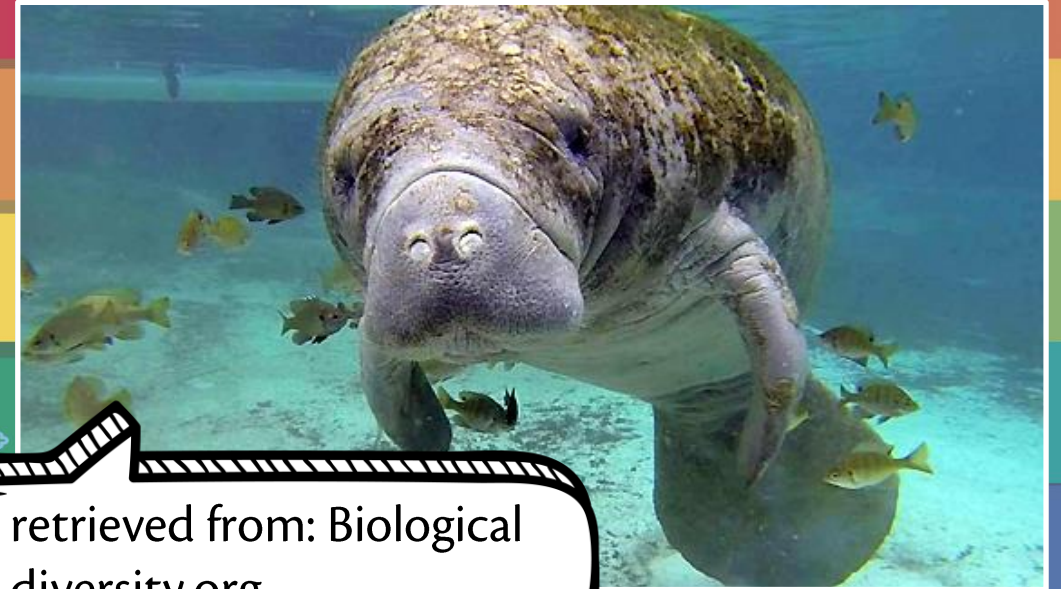
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My habitat's colors

The Mimic octopus is **pale brown** with **brown** and white stripes. It is a venomous creature which changes its shape and color to impersonate at least 15 other sea creatures.



The Southern Pygmy Leatherjackets have a colour pattern, ranging from **pale yellowish-brown** to **dark green** and they change color when they fall in love.



The cuttlefish is **brown** and it changes its shape, color, and texture according to the background which makes him able to camouflage, and hunt in.

People usually wear colorful clothes. Buildings and houses often stand out for their paint. All of these influences the way people are. That is why, we see so many cheerful people with a positive attitude.



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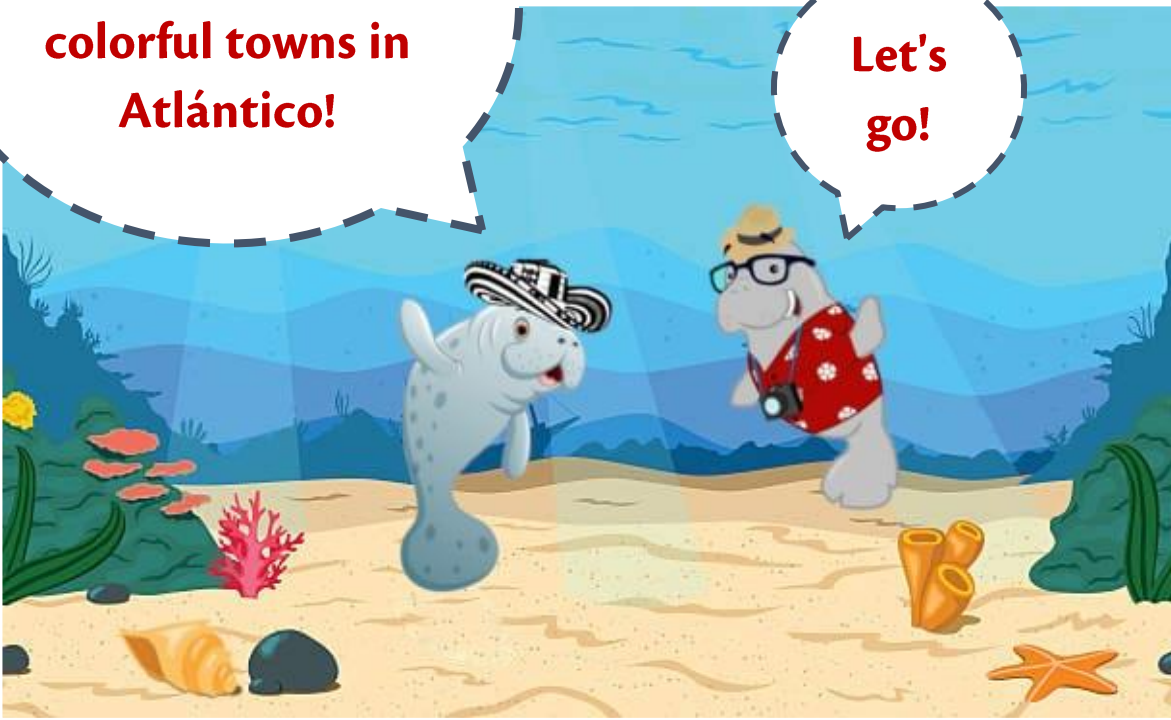
