People can enjoy the performance of great local and international artists in the Orchestra Festival or concerts that take place in the department.



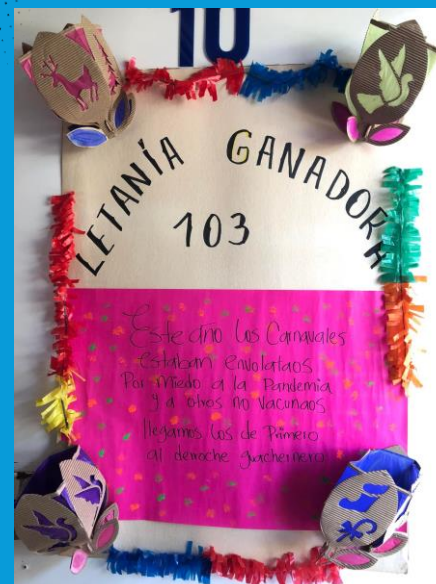
